

#### Greetings in the name of Christ!

It has truly been a joyful summer, as hopefully all of us were able to participate in activities that were lost to us during the height of the pandemic. For my family, we traveled to Colorado for a long deferred vacation. My son Sully got to see his paternal grandfather and grandmother who he had not seen since the pandemic began. It was a blessing to see Sully play and learn with other children at community events and at our church's Vacation Bible School. This summer made me thankful for so much of the little things the pandemic took away from us.

I am also grateful for the coronavirus vaccines that made all of this possible. I truly believe that these vaccines are an answer to prayer. While there are still risks of coronavirus infection and transmission among vaccinated people, the rates of both are far lower. Current studies show that 99.5% of recent COVID-19 deaths were unvaccinated people. If you are able to be vaccinated, I strongly encourage you to do so. We not only protect ourselves, we also protect vulnerable members of our society, like children and youth and the immunocompromised, and those who are unable to be vaccinated. We can care for one another, particularly the vulnerable, by getting vaccinated. Paul tells us in Philippians to look after the interests of others (Philippians 2:3-4), and receiving the vaccine is one way of doing that. I fear that as the Delta variant spreads, we run the risk of returning to many of the restrictive measures that existed before the vaccine rollout. I enjoy gathering in worship with little to no restrictions and pray that we can stay this way. That's why I'm asking you to lovingly encourage your friends and neighbors who are unvaccinated to receive the vaccine if they are able.

On another note, I have a few important things I'd like to share. First, please consider signing up to sponsor a table at our church's "Back to School Bash" on August 11th from 5:00 PM – 8:00 PM. Each table has a designated activity, and we need your help! You can check out the sign up sheet on the table near the restrooms, and can learn more information by talking to Gayla Van Horn or by calling the church office. Second, we are starting an informal partnership with the preschool that meets in our church. In the next few weeks, you will get an opportunity to "sponsor" a preschool student. If you choose to sponsor a student, you will learn a few details about him/her, such as their birthday and their favorite activities and interests. We hope that if you sponsor a child, you will consider sending them cards, letters, and small gifts at various points throughout the year, as well as keep them and their family in your prayers. We as a church are trying to be more intentional about reaching young families, and these are two ways we are trying to do just that.








### CARNIVAL

Received estimate for sliding glass door at the parsonage from St Albans Window for \$2290. Second estimate for installation of door only, if door purchased separately, from an individual. Total cost roughly the same, so going with St Albans Window. It was decided to withdraw and use \$3000 from Heron fund to cover cost of door. Replaced light in bedroom in parsonage. Issue with parsonage garage door. GDO came and fixed the issue. Sanctuary carpet needs cleaned. Looking at waiting until fall to do so.

STAFF/PARISH RELATIONS COMMITTEE- Met and completed pastor evaluation and set new goals for pastor.
