The Winfield United Methodist Church Administrative Council meeting was called to order by Al Ruebush at 7:02 PM on September 27, 2021.

Opening prayer by Pastor Chris Scott

Minutes from the August 23, 2021 meeting were read. Motion to accept minutes made by Bill Davis. Motion voted on and approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Beginning Balance 41,811.30

August Income 24,527.68 August Expense 16,978.70 Ending Balance 49,360.28

\$6000 from Heron fund withdraw included in August income

COMMITTEES

BOARD OF TRUSTEES: Did not meet.

STAFF/PARISH RELATIONS COMMITTEE: No report. Will meet Wednesday, October 6.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEAM: Trunk or Treat scheduled for October 27 from 6-8. Next meeting Sunday, November 7.

FINANCE COMMITTEE: Did not meet. Have not set 2022 budget. Had previously voted to not give any employees a salary raise for next year.

UNITED METHODIST WOMEN: The UMW sponsored church wide picnic on August 29 went well. Sent out 34 invitations to members that haven't returned to church in a while for it, only one family came in response to it. Looking for outside fundraiser ideas. May also change format of meetings.

MISSIONS TEAM: Christmas applications started September 1 at Heart and Hand. Mission team has requested 40 names for this year.

MEN'S GROUP: Did not meet.

TECHNOLOGY TEAM: Steve will be gone at the end of October. Kyle Capehart will run tech equipment for the Sunday service. Beyond Faith town hall on September 28 will be livestreamed.

PASTORS REPORT: Preschool Partners have been paired with a church sponsor. September 28, here at the church from 5-8 is a "Beyond Faith" town Hall. October 3 is Charge Conference at the church. October 4 will be Blessing of the animals. Working outside of the church office on Mondays. Will be in the office Tuesday-Thursday.

OLD BUSINESS- Youth was donated a "new" TV after old one died. Daniel Bellamy, a Ph.D. student at UC has spoken with Pastor Chris about playing piano, possibly leading the choir. The church needs to find out what the time commitment it would be for him, since he is a college student, and if we need/can afford it sometime in the future. He would cost \$400-\$600 a month. Finishing up Charge Conference paperwork by answering 2 questions-1. Name 3 strengths the church has (1. Support and uplift members in need, 2. Strong backpack buddy program, 3. Strong core constituency) and 2. Challenges as a congregation we need to address over the next 12 months (1. Reaching and retaining/engaging new people, 2. Balancing budget, 3. Learning to embrace new leadership and ideas).

NEW BUSINESS- Steve Burdette made a motion to start a monthly community breakfast here at the church, beginning in October, every third Saturday from 8-11, with dining in the adult classroom, and a short devotional afterward by Pastor Chris. Motion voted on and passed. Steve will need at least 3 additional volunteers to help, starting at 7 AM. Kendra Sullivan and Kim Porter have requested use of the adult classroom to do a craft fundraiser for a birth-3 worker. Request was approved by the Trustees.

Being no further business, a motion was made by Steve Burdette to adjourn the meeting. Meeting was adjourned.
