#### 11:00 AM: Late Service


Larger service but is still relaxed, a blending of traditional and contemporary touches.

The Winfield United Methodist Church Administrative Council meeting was called to order by Al Ruebush at 6:56 PM on February 28, 2022.

Opening prayer by Pastor Chris Scott

Educational Session-Pastor Chris presented a hand out on the 3 places to find new church leaders. Al Ruebush discussed how many items were accomplished from our strategic plan. Pretty much everything we set out to accomplish was successful. Would like council to think about the most important things we need to do as church for 2022 and discuss it at next meeting.

Steve Burdette made a motion to move the Administrative Council meeting in March from Monday, March 28 at 7 PM to Saturday, March 19 at 10:30 AM. Motion voted on and approved.

Denny Sansom will contact Affordable Steam Cleaner to get dates to finish stripping and waxing floors. Sink spray nozzle in kitchen sink has been installed and working well. Kathy Burns made a motion for Denny Sansom to continue as Chair of Trustees. Motion voted on and approved. Will need to fill vacancy left in trustees by the passing of Arbie Webb. It is time to sign HVAC maintenance agreement with Abston and Sons. Estimates and replacement for a new fence at the parsonage is a project priority for 2022.

STAFF/PARISH RELATIONS COMMITTEE- Met February 9, 2022. Gayla reported on youth/children's programs. SPRC will meet once a quarter, with the next meeting being May 11, 2022 at 7 PM. Chris made a report on his duties. Kim Porter informed committee that she will be moving to Pennsylvania by years end and her position on the committee will need to be filled.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEAM- Children's Church has been restarted during the 11 service. Combining nursery and children's church workers so there will no longer be 2 workers in the nursery throughout the late service. Doing Lent programs at youth and SPARK. Easter Egg Glow Hunt scheduled for Saturday, April 9 from 8-9 PM. All kids in the community will be invited. Will need several volunteers. Discussing possible VBS options. Meeting again March 13 at 12:15.

Restarting Burgers and Bibles next Tuesday at Wendy's instead of McDonald's. Attended a district wide meeting held by the Bishop. Pastor Chris was asked to sit on an unofficial conference communication team. Following Ash Wednesday, will finish up the 7 signs of Christ for Bible Study. Completed Pre marital counselling and performed a wedding for John and Christy Killian on 2/22/22.

#### OLD BUSINESS- None

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>- Denny made a motion to no longer require masks in the church except in cases where you are working with children 5 and under. A discussion was had about phrasing, since masks were not required previously only strongly encouraged. Steve Burdette made a motion to change the wording "no longer required" to "make masks optional". After some final discussion, Denny made a final motion to make mask wearing optional unless you are working with kids that are unable to be vaccinated (5 and under).
